Applicants must fulfill the following:

- More than 10 years' experience after PG in nursing education, clinical practice, or public health.

2. Responsibilities of Resource Person

- Deliver a structured online session aligned with CNPD objectives.
- Share evidence-based insights, case studies, and practical tools.
- Engage participants through discussion and Q&A.
- Prepare and support pre/post-test assessments.

3. Remuneration & Recognition

- Rs. 2500/- per session per person.
- Certificate with one credit point.

2.	Professional Experience in Relevant Field
3.	Subject Expertise and Specialization
4.	Experience as Resource Person/Speaker
5.	Publications, Research, or Academic Contributions
